I remember being like, ‘Oh my God, I’m going to be 25 when I’m finished. It seemed so far away.’ As for saying goodbye to Katniss for good, she said: “It does feel over. It didn’t for a while and I didn’t think it would ever sink in, but it has now. It feels over. And that’s okay. It’s okay to move on.”

Director David O. Russell, who has worked with Jennifer on “Silver Linings Playbook,” (for which she took home the Best Actress Oscar) “American Hustle,” and the upcoming “Joy,” sings her praises just like the rest of the world does. He said: “Jen’s the same person, this girl from Kentucky who is becoming a woman. I’ve gotten the privilege of watching that. That’s also the story of this movie. It’s a lot for a 25-year-old. But it’s happening. Jennifer is really finding her own voice.”
