Even better: "25" is only the second album to sell more than 2 million copies in a single week since Nielsen Music began tracking sales in 1991. By the end of the day today, it's on track to surpass the single-week sales record, currently held by *NSYNC's "No Strings Attached," which debuted with 2.4 million sold in a week back in March 2000.
